DO YOU KNOW? An estimated one in 13 children is impacted by allergies. Many children experience events for the first time while in child care, including new foods and insect bites. There is no way to predict when a child will have an allergic reaction. If anaphylaxis were to occur, is your child care program prepared to respond? Epinephrine is the first line drug of choice for the emergency treatment of severe allergic reactions. Having a non-patient specific auto-injector in your program's emergency tool kit, and the knowledge on how to use it, is a lifesaving investment. REGULATION REVIEW



Self-Reporting

41*.15(b) (14) The caregiver must immediately notify the parent and Office upon learning of the following events involving a child which occurred while the child was in care at the program or was being transported by a caregiver:

(i) death,

(ii) serious incident,

(iii) serious injury,

(iv) serious condition,

(v) communicable disease, or

(vi) transportation to a hospital.

Daily Health Checks

Health care Plan Section 3: Daily Health Checks:

A daily health check will be done for each child when the child <u>arrives</u> at the program and <u>whenever a change</u> in the child's behavior and/or appearance is noted. the child must <u>be awake</u> when the check is done.

The Daily Health Check must be documented on LDSS-4433 (Child Care Attendance Sheet) or a form developed by your program.

WATER PAINTING

- 1. Fill a small cup with water.
- 2. Add Paint brushes, sponges or rollers to apply water.
- 3. Paint the fence or wall with water with the child and talk about what is happening.
- 4. Use different brushes, etc. to discover how the water is applied.

Treasure hunt

Treasure hunts help children learn problem-solving skills, how to follow directions, and how to work together to find "treasure." To play this game, create a list of items for children to find, a simple map or directions to follow, and a "treasure chest" that can be filled with the items they will hunt for. Hide the objects on your list throughout the outdoor playing area and have your children follow the map to collect all the items. Once they've found all the items, place them in the treasure chest.
